



City of The Village Sewer Line Maintenance

The City of The Village owns, operates and maintains the **sanitary sewer collection system** for the City of The Village. The Village does not have a **sewage treatment facility** and all of the sewerage from The Village goes to Oklahoma City treatments facilities, which are located to the north of The Village.

SEWER RATES: Residents of The Village must pay the City of The Village a Sewer Line Maintenance Fee of \$6.80 per month (\$13.40 per billing period). Residents also have to pay Oklahoma City for Sewage Treatment. Oklahoma City's rates are based on water usage.

SEWER PROBLEMS? For sewer problems contact The Village Sewer Department first at 751-4933, after hours and weekends call 751-9598. Never call a plumber first unless you are sure that the problem is on your own lines. It is usually best to let the City check the problem out first before calling a plumber. The City **will not** pay your plumbing bill if a plumber comes out and determines that the problem is on the City main.

WHERE DOES MY LINE BEGIN? The City **only** maintains the city sewer main. The City's responsibility does not include the riser, which attaches to and comes out of the City main. Everything from the City's main line to the home is the responsibility of the resident.

INSURANCE: Make sure that your homeowners or renters insurance policy covers sewer backups. Oftentimes, a special endorsement is needed for this coverage. Sewer backups can be extremely costly and the City **does not insure or guarantee** that the sewer system will always function properly.
